COURSE DESCRIPTION

Reading Between the Red and White

9:30am - 10:00am

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Color changes in the oral mucosa often hold diagnostic clues to conditions ranging from benign irritation to early malignancy. This lecture explores white, red, and mixed red-white lesions through a practical, pattern-based approach. We'll review common entities such as hyperkeratosis, lichen planus, leukoplakia, erythroplakia, and oral carcinoma, focusing on their distinguishing features, diagnostic pitfalls, and biopsy principles. Emphasis will be placed on when to watch, when to worry, and when to refer, helping clinicians recognize high-risk lesions and improve early detection.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- Recognize and differentiate common oral white, red, and mixed red-white lesions, including common entities seen in daily practice.
- Apply a practical approach to determine when to watch, and when to refer or biopsy, using clinical patterns and diagnostic clues.
- Understand the principles of biopsy and clinicopathologic correlation to optimize diagnosis and management of mucosal color changes.

DR. MICHELLE HUANG BIO

Dr. Michelle Huang is a graduate of the Oral Pathology and Oral Medicine program at the University of Toronto, Department of Dentistry. She maintains an active clinical practice at Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre and serves as a clinical instructor at the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Toronto. Dr. Huang is a fellow of the Royal College of Dentists of Canada and a member of the Canadian Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology and Oral Medicine (CAOMPOM), the American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology (AAOMP), and the Ontario Dental Association.

The Importance of A Healthy Body for The Periodontal/Implant Patient

10:35am - 11:15am

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Successful implant therapy relies on more than precise surgical technique. Systemic health and nutrition influence every phase of healing and can significantly affect early failure, marginal bone loss, and peri-implant disease.

This course examines the critical interplay between systemic health and dental implant outcomes, with a focus on the emerging science of osteoimmunology and host modulation. It reframes implant dentistry through a metabolic and immunological lens, exploring how factors such as nutrition, lipid metabolism, vitamin D status, diabetes, smoking, and systemic inflammation shape osseointegration, peri-implant bone stability, and the risk of peri-implantitis.

Participants will gain insights from cutting-edge research and learn practical chairside strategies to assess patient risk, communicate effectively, and design treatment plans that support both oral and systemic health.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- Define osteoimmunology and explain its relevance to implant healing and peri-implant disease.
- Identify key systemic and lifestyle factors (e.g., vitamin D deficiency, elevated LDL, smoking, diabetes, poor nutrition) that influence implant survival and bone stability.
- Evaluate patient risk profiles using clinical history, systemic biomarkers, and lifestyle assessments.
- Communicate the impact of systemic health on implant outcomes using relatable analogies and visual tools to enhance patient understanding.

DR. KRISTY BAILEY BIO

Dr. Véronique Benhamou is a certified periodontist and implant surgeon with over 30 years of clinical and academic experience. She serves as Director of the Division of Periodontology at McGill University's Faculty of Dental Medicine and Oral Health Sciences, leading advanced training in bone regeneration, aesthetic periodontal surgery, and implantology. A graduate of the Goldman School of Graduate Dentistry in Boston, she has received multiple awards for teaching excellence. Dr. Benhamou maintains a private practice in Montreal and lectures on digital workflows and interdisciplinary care.
